Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to advise you of a couple of changes relating to the staffing of our curriculum.

Unfortunately due to personal circumstances, Mr Wilbor made the request during half-term to step down from his position as Head of Physical Education with immediate effect.

Whilst I was disappointed with the situation, under the circumstances I was left with no alternative than to respect his decision and allow him to terminate his contract.

Whilst we are disappointed to lose Mr Robbins, it is his decision that for personal reasons he has decided to return to the role of classroom Geography teacher at another school.

Every effort was made in attempt to keep Mr Robbins with us at Winterton but ultimately I respect his decision to do what he feels is right for him at this time.

I am sure you will join me in thanking Mr Robbins and wish him every success in his new post.

As a result, we have moved quickly this week to appoint a new Head of Humanities and I am delighted to say that in January, Miss Monteith will take up the post.

Miss Monteith is an experienced humanities teacher, developing her practice across a couple of schools in North Lincolnshire.
