I am delighted to share with you, the final outcome of our most recent OFSTED inspection which recognises that Winterton Community Academy continues to be a good school.

After what is known to have been a difficult time for the school back in 2017-18, the inspection team recognised that significant improvements had been made since this time and that the school was also continuing to improve. Under the new OFSTED framework, there is a significant emphasis on the quality of education provided, including the curriculum and also on the behaviour and attitudes of our pupils. I am delighted that the outcome demonstrates the overall effectiveness of the school to be good.

I understand that not all parents and carers yet have faith and trust in us and we will continue to work hard, to create opportunities to listen to your views and to strive to fulfil our vision of ensuring that every child who attends Winterton Community Academy will indeed be safe, happy and successful.
