Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been so lovely to welcome our students back to school this week albeit under some guidelines and restrictions, they have settled in quickly and they are a credit to you.

After such a difficult period where they have not been able to enjoy many of the things that they would ordinarily do, I am really keen for us as a school to try and put some enrichment activities in place as soon as possible.

Therefore, from next week, we are going to start running some extra-curricular activities on designated evenings.

Multi-Sports Club

The purpose of the sports club will be to allow pupils to turn up and decide what activities they want to participate in. The activities will be supervised, but to enable us to offer as diverse a range of activity as possible, they will not be coached. The format will be free-play, allowing them to decide whether they want to take part in a game of football, netball, cricket, basketball, badminton or whatever else it is that they want to do. Providing there are sufficient numbers to play, then we will let them get on with it.

Art and Design

In a similar way to the sports club, there will be a range of activities available and students will be able to decide what they want to do.

The clubs will run after school from 3:30pm until 4:30pm. If your child wishes to participate in the sports club, then they will need wear appropriate PE kit.

If you are able to advise us of your consent before 4pm on Monday 15th March then it would help us with our arrangements however we still allow students to attend if they decide later, so long as we receive consent.
