Dear Parent / Carers,

It is important to note the value we place on school uniform being worn smartly and with pride. This is a timely reminder to ensure that you are aware of our uniform expectations so that you can ensure your son / daughter returns to school after the half term holiday in correct school uniform as detailed below.

The full uniform list is as follows: (for students in Years 8-10, unless they chose to wear the 'new' uniform.

Trousers – Boys or Girls

- Must be plain black or dark grey, tailored style fitted on the waist.
- Minimum length to the anklebone – socks (dark) should not be visible.

Jeans or jean like, chinos, any tight fitting trousers including leggings, trousers with prominent zips on the pockets and rolled up trousers showing socks are not permitted.

Skirts – Girls

- Must be plain black or dark grey, preferably no shorter than knee length. Lycra, cord and miniskirts or skirts with a high slit are not allowed.

Cardigans / Sweaters – All Students

- School badged cardigan or sweater must be worn at all times in and around the building

Polo Shirts – All Students

- School badged navy polo shirts

Shoes and Footwear

- Black, polishable, sensible footwear only

No hoodies are to be worn in school – unless they are P.E. Hoodies in school colours with a school badge.

The new, year seven uniform is detailed below. Any student in any year group can chose to wear this uniform.

Jewellery

- For students with piercings only one stud is permitted per ear. One simple, discrete nose piercing is allowed. No hooped earrings are to be worn.

Hair

- Hair should be a natural colour. Ask if you are not sure.

Make-up

- Make-up should be natural looking and therefore not clearly visible.
- Nail varnish should be a natural colour.


False nails / acrylics and false eyelashes are not allowed in school.
