ATTITUDE TO LEARNING (A2L) DESCRIPTORS

The school has moved to a single attitude to learning grade which combines behaviour and effort. The expected level for pupils is a 'C' if they are exhibiting the behaviour and effort required to achieve the expected level of attainment. The attitude grades are as follows...

VERY GOOD	BEHAVIOUR:	Good levels of focus, attention and cooperation in class. Positive and helpful in lessons
	EFFORT:	Tries hard in lessons and with homework. Can follow instruction willingly and thoroughly. Always ready and equipped to learn.
EXPECTED	BEHAVIOUR:	Acceptable levels of focus, attention and cooperation in class. Can be positive and helpful in lessons
	EFFORT:	Completes all classwork set to an acceptable standard. Homework is usually completed but would benefit from greater effort.
NEEDS IMPROVING	BEHAVIOUR:	Usually acceptable but sometimes behaviour can be disruptive, making it harder for students to learn and teachers to teach.
	EFFORT:	Usually completes all tasks set but sometimes needs reminders to remain on task and give maximum effort. This has had an impact on the predicted grade compared to the Standard Target.
UNACCEPTABLE	BEHAVIOUR:	Regularly displays disruptive behaviour which prevents other students from learning and teachers from teaching.
	EFFORT:	Makes little apparent effort with classwork and homework. Needs frequent reminders to stay on task.
