Dear Parent / Guardian,

I hope that this letter finds you well and that you are looking forward to the summer holidays as much as we are!

Prior to the holidays commencing and the new school year in September, I would like to take a moment to share with you the Academy's expectations with regards to school uniform for September 2025 and a very subtle change that we are making. Full details of the uniform can also be found on the school website.

We have very clear expectations for our school uniform. Please see details of this below:

Year 7 – 11 – white shirt, school tie and blazer with grey school trousers, grey tailored shorts or school skirt.

Sensible black footwear should be worn by all students. (Please note, we do not stipulate here school shoes and therefore, there is flexibility to wearing sensible black footwear for comfort and support. (This is a change to current school uniform expectations).

Please note:

Black tube skirts / black skirts / leggings / hoodies / fluffy socks are not part of the school uniform and should not be worn in school.

I would also like to remind you that in readiness for returning to school in September, false acrylic nails, hooped earrings and nose hoops are not allowed. These should not be worn in school for health and safety reasons.

Students are permitted to wear one pair of stud earrings and one discrete nose stud. Hair should be of a natural colour and any makeup should be discrete and natural.

If your son / daughter has an issue with uniform that needs rectifying, please communicate this with their tutor at the start of the year so that support and discretion can be applied.

In readiness for what will be a fantastic school year ahead, I would like to thank you for your support in encouraging and promoting high standards of uniform and appearance.
